Be prepared to:

- Work with basic hand tools.
- Do measuring activities with a standard ruler.
- Draw pictures based on moods/emotion/words.
- Problem solve in a group activity.
- Follow instructions to build a simple object.
- Learn to use a computer for drawing.
- Hand in a written essay/statement (5-7 sentences long) explaining why you want to attend *School of the Arts*. **BE SURE TO WRITE ABOUT WHY YOU ARE INTERESTED IN THEATRE TECHNOLOGY!**
- Hand in a *Confidential Applicant Snapshot* from a past or current teacher.

What you need to bring with you:

- Please bring any three of the following:
 - Your ideas for a Dollhouse Ground Plan (living room, kitchen, bedroom, etc.).
 - Something built from wood, like a box or bird house.
 - A list of sets and props from an episode of your favorite TV show, movie or cartoon.
 - Written ideas or plans about how you would build a bookshelf.
 - Examples of Computer Art or Computer Drawing you created.
 - A Drawing, Painting or Paper Mache project that you created at home or in your art class that you are proud of.
- Your written essay/statement about why you want to attend *School of the Arts*.
- Your completed *Confidential Applicant Snapshot* (this may be mailed directly to SOTA AUDITIONS)

CHECKLIST FOR YOUR AUDITION:

- ✓ I have at least three examples of things I have built, drawn or created.
- ✓ I have written my statement of why I want to study Theatre Technology at *School of the Arts*.
