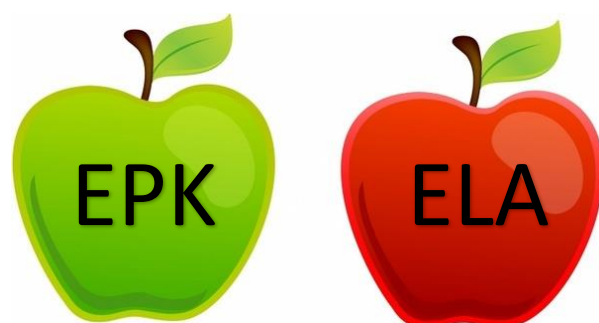

## Materials for Session 1
