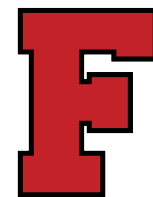

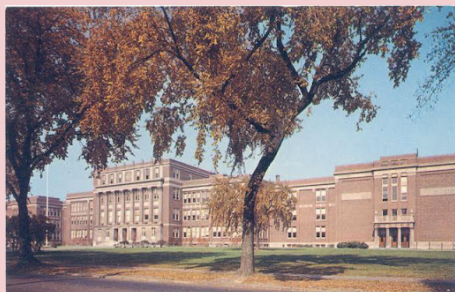
Attendance Matters!!!
