Science/Social Studies

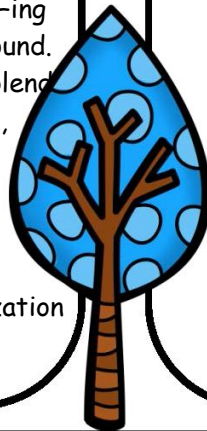
- Science concepts will continue to be taught through our ELA curriculum. We will continue to learn about plant/animal life cycles.
- In Social Studies, we will begin learning about "Symbols of Citizenship", such as the Pledge of Allegiance and knowledge of the American flag.

ELA

We will continue our learning in Unit 2 of the myView curriculum.

Some main learning concepts that will be addressed are:

- Phonics: final consonant blends, -s and -ing ending words, digraphs (sh, th), long a sound.
- Phonological Awareness: segment and blend phonemes, rhyming words, medial sounds, short and long a words.
- Reading informational text, poetry, and drama.
- High-frequency word practice.
- Writing sentences with proper capitalization and punctuation.



Math

In January, we will focus on working with larger numbers (all the way up to 100).

Some main learning concepts are:

- Counting on or making 10 to solve result unknown and total unknown problems.
- Decomposition and composition strategies.
- Identification of 10 as a unit.
- Continued practice with addition and subtraction.

Social-Emotional Learning

Throughout the month of January, we will continue to focus on Empathy. Lessons will include identification of feelings, looking at clues to understand how someone else is feeling, similarities/differences with emotions, welcoming/inviting behaviors, understanding of what an "accident" is, and showing care/compassion towards others.
