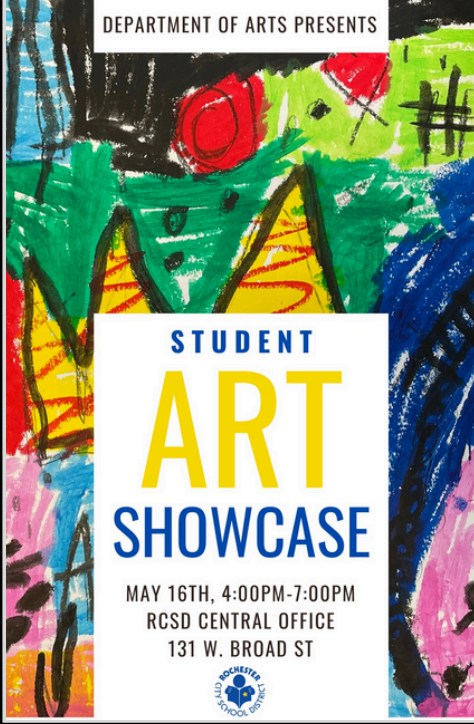
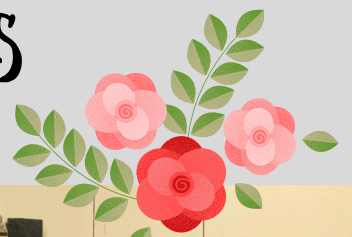

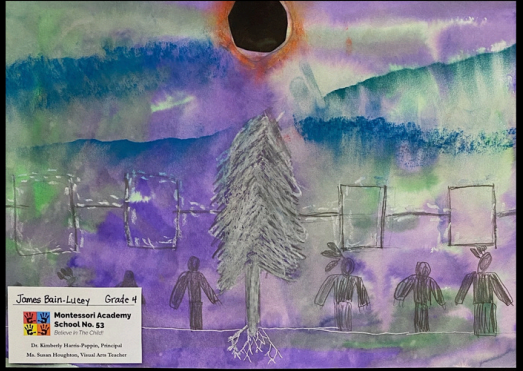

It is now the last quarter of the year and our Montessori artists are hustling to create lots of art before the school year ends!

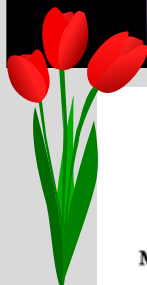
Primary artists practiced a new line, the Spiral, as they created watercolor "Snailscapes" and learned about these garden creatures.
