Upper El - Grade 6



Sixth grade artists created a winter wonderland landscape using a watercolor palette. They created a foreground, mid-ground, and background then painted black silhouette details.

Primary - Kinder/Pk4

They stand 3 feet tall in our foyer, and each one is unique and vibrant. The inspiration for this project comes from the book *Nutcracker in Harlem* by T.E. McMorrow.
