### MIDDLE EL

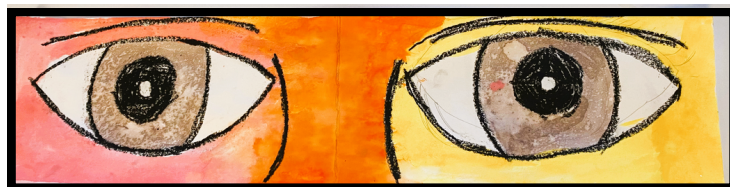
